Ecoist is mostly known for its line of handbags made from recycled candy wrappers, food packages, and soda labels. As part of its commitment to environmental restoration, Ecoist plants a tree for every handbag sold.

The wrappers are cut, folded, handwoven, and sewn by talented artisans in Mexico and Peru.

Ecoist handbags are made from factory misprints or overages of candy wrappers, soda labels, food packages and other waste-bound materials that could otherwise end up in landfills.

Ecoist works with cooperatives, and non-profit organizations that operate fair trade, sustainable manufacturing in underprivileged communities.

Handbags can be sent back to Ecoist for disassembly or other reuses. At Ecoist, nothing goes to waste. Eco-fashion knows no limits. Sustainable style that unites all ages and all races worldwide.
